Spring 2022 Registration Timeline

August 30 - October 8: Honors Advising Appointments Available

- This timeframe provides the option to meet with your Honors Advisor prior to the start of registration. It is your responsibility to schedule an appointment in a timely manner.
- Your Honors Advisor will be available after registration begins for follow-up appointments.

October 1: Registration date and time posted in My Illinois State

- Check the Academics tab for your registration time.

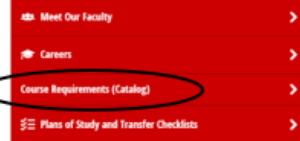

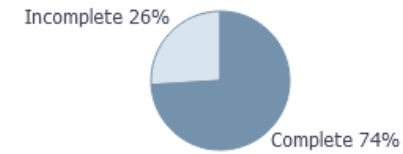
