- GPA of 3.5 or greater
- Written reflection on campus/community involvement, and/or work experience
- A minimum of three semesters remaining at Illinois State University

Admitted students begin their Honors coursework during the fall semester with enrollment in the one credit hour Honors Mindset Seminar (HON 102A17).
